Headquartered in Fairfax, Virginia, ManTech International Corporation is a leading provider of innovative technologies and solutions for mission-critical national security programs for the Intelligence Community; the departments of Defense, State, Homeland Security, and Justice; the Space Community; and other U.S. federal government customers. ManTech's expertise includes systems engineering, systems integration, technology and software development, enterprise security architecture, information assurance, intelligence operations support, network and critical infrastructure protection, information technology, communications integration and engineering support. The company supports the advanced telecommunications systems that are used in Operation Iraqi Freedom and in other parts of the world; provides the physical and cyber security to protect U.S. embassies all over the world; has developed a secure, collaborative communications system for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and builds and maintains secure databases that track terrorists. The company operates in the United States and over 40 countries worldwide. In 2005, Red Herring magazine selected ManTech as one of its Small Cap 100 Companies; and in 2006, Business 2.0 magazine named ManTech one of its 100 Fastest Growing Technology Companies in 2006 and 2007. In May 2007, ManTech acquired SRS Technologies, which is now a wholly owned subsidiary named ManTech SRS Technologies, Incorporated. Founded in 1970, ManTech SRS (www.srs.com) is a highly diversified provider of advanced technology services focused on C4ISR (military command, control, computer communications-intelligence-surveillance-reconnaissance), IT services, aeronautics, environmental systems, missile systems, modeling and simulation, safety and quality assurance and test and evaluation. ManTech SRS has a successful, 35-year lineage in delivering these solutions to commercial customers and major government agencies, including the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO), Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Defense Advanced Research Project Agency (DARPA), National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), among many others.

On 1 January 2009, NeXolve Corporation split from ManTech SRS Technologies to resolve a conflict of interest issues with another line of business. NeXolve is also a wholly owned subsidiary of ManTech International. Document Detective is still marketed as a ManTech International product, but SRS Technologies and NeXolve may still appear in some of our paperwork.
